In 2015, the EU began cutting the availability of hydroflourocarbons (HFC's). There is a planeed total reduction of these gasses of 79% by 2030. This is part of an international phase out.

The 37% supply reduction of HFC's for 2018/19 to the UK by this regulation has resulted in the manufacturers raising their prices by a minimun of **180%** per KG of FM200.

From the 1st of January 2018, the price of FM200 has gone from £25 to £70 per KG. This ultimately means that the cost of the HFC-227ea gas left in circulation will only continue to rise in the forthcoming months and years.
